Please use the Visitors car park which is the first turning on Red Cross Lane and is clearly signed. Please report to Reception who will provide you with a car parking pass to put in your car for the duration of your meeting.

From the Cambridge railway station:

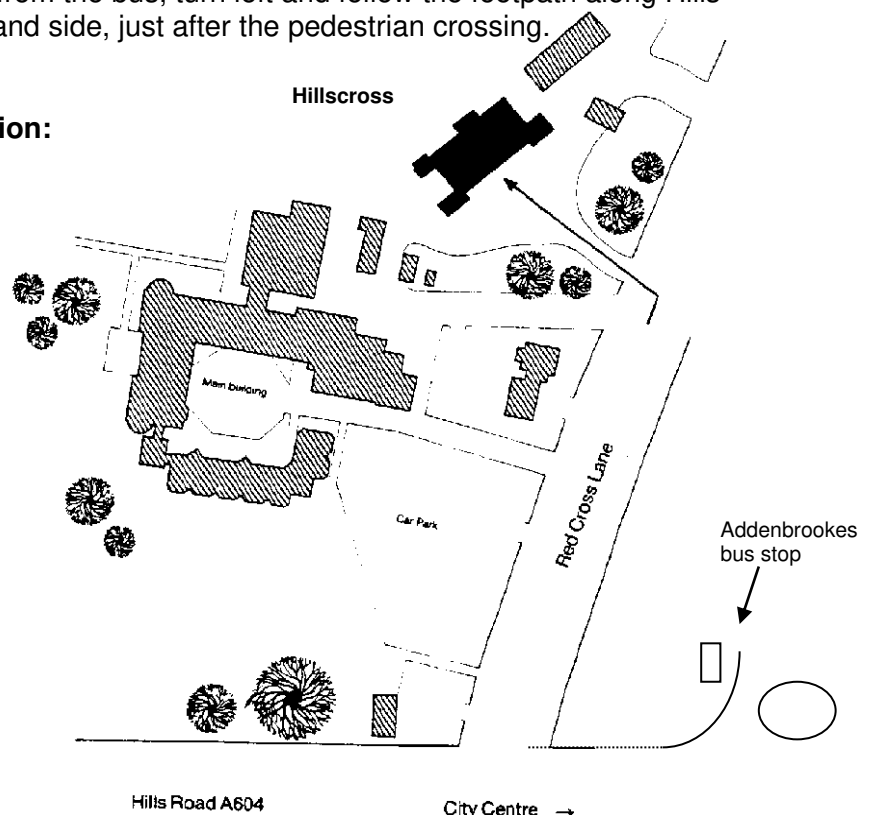
Taxi: There is a taxi rank just outside the station. Most drivers will be familiar with The Bell School, "near Addenbrookes".

Bus: Buses run approximately every 10 minutes from the station to Addenbrookes Hospital Roundabout. The journey will take 10-15 minutes. (Check with the driver that the bus is headed toward Addenbrookes.) After alighting from the bus, turn left and follow the footpath along Hills Road to Red Cross Lane on the right hand side, just after the pedestrian crossing.

From the Drummer Street coach station:

Taxi: There is a taxi rank across the road from the National Express coach stand. Most drivers will be familiar with The Bell School, "near Addenbrookes".

Bus: Buses run frequently to Addenbrookes Hospital Roundabout, on routes 1, 2, 7, 8, and 13. The journey will take approximately 15-20 minutes. A green "park & ride" bus (towards Babraham Road", goes most frequently and has the shortest route. After alighting from the bus, turn left and follow the path along Hills Road to Red Cross Lane on the right hand side, just after the pedestrian crossing.



By road:

From the M11 (South): Leave the M11 at Junction 9 and continue north for approx. 3.5 miles along the A11. Take the first exit to Cambridge, and turn left at the roundabout along the A1307. Drive for 4 miles to the outskirts of Cambridge. Red Cross Lane is on the left, just before a pedestrian crossing. (If you reach the Addenbrookes Hospital roundabout, you have gone too far).

From the M11 (North): Leave the M11 at Junction 11 (Cambridge South). Follow the A10 through Trumpington for approx. 3 miles. Turn right into Long Road (follow signs for Addenbrookes Hospital). At the traffic lights at the end of Long Road, turn right. Go straight through the roundabout along Hills Road (sign posted Haverhill). Red Cross Lane is on the right hand side, just after the pedestrian crossing.

From the A14 (East): Leave the A14 at the first Cambridge exit and follow the A1303 past the airport, as far as the first roundabout. Turn left onto the A1134. You are now on the ring road. Follow this road approx 2.5 miles until you reach the Addenbrookes Hospital roundabout. Turn left into Hills Road (sign posted Haverhill). Red Cross Lane is on the right hand side, just after the pedestrian crossing.
